AFFILIATE

All Affiliates and clubs will have been sent a letter with regards to some rule changes and confirmation from AON with regards to the holding of Clinics. All clinicians who are asked to conduct a clinic at any Club or Affiliate must have and produce proof of their insurance, which needs to be forwarded to the office with approval form. HSAA Judges may conduct clinics and will be covered under the HSAA Judges insurance.

All classes covered in the Rule Book will be referred to as sanctioned classes. Those classes that are run by a Club or Affiliates such as Beginner/Improver, Walk jog using class rules as guidelines and using legal headgear will be referred to as Non-sanctioned classes. Please note that activities other than Show events specified in our Rule Book are not covered by our insurance, however social activities for Affiliate or Club members only (Not Day Members) that have been submitted to HSAA for approval and minute by the Club prior to the event will be covered.

A reminder that when using HSAA and AQHA judges in order to meet with insurance requirements and request that Affiliates put in their show conditions: Any person riding on the grounds regardless of whether they are competing must pay a day fee sign a waiver otherwise they are not covered by insurance.

RULE CHANGES 201/2016

Rule 109B Hunter in Hand Tack Appointments

Reins or lead must be held in both hands.

Rule 106 Score 0 - Add Failure to demonstrate correct lead or gait, if designated.

Rule 109A Lunge Line (remove Yearling)

We look to adopting the AQHA rules for this event

Rule 109 Led Trail (remove Yearling)

Use same scoring system and penalties as per Rule 106 Trail Class with the addition of 3 point penalty for stepping in or on an obstacles unless specified.

Western Dressage paragraph be removed from the Rule Book
